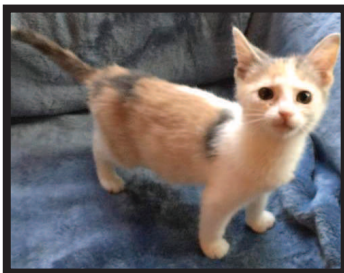

Purr-fect Pals

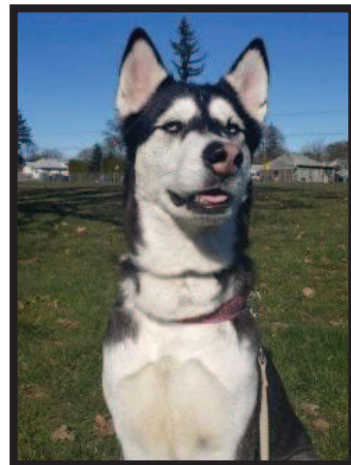
