With Columbia County being given the green light to enter Phase I of re-opening we have been asked on several occasions when the shelter will be opening again. For right now, it has been the collective decision of both the Board of Directors and the staff to not re-open the lobby or the cattery to the public or volunteers at this time. We feel that due to the size of these areas we will be unable to follow proper social distancing protocols putting both our staff and our visitors at risk. We will remain open for adoptions and owner surrenders as we have since March, everything will still just continue to happen by appointment only. Adoption screenings will start by email or phone calls, followed up by appointments for people to come and meet the pets that they are interested in if they are good matches for your home. 
