

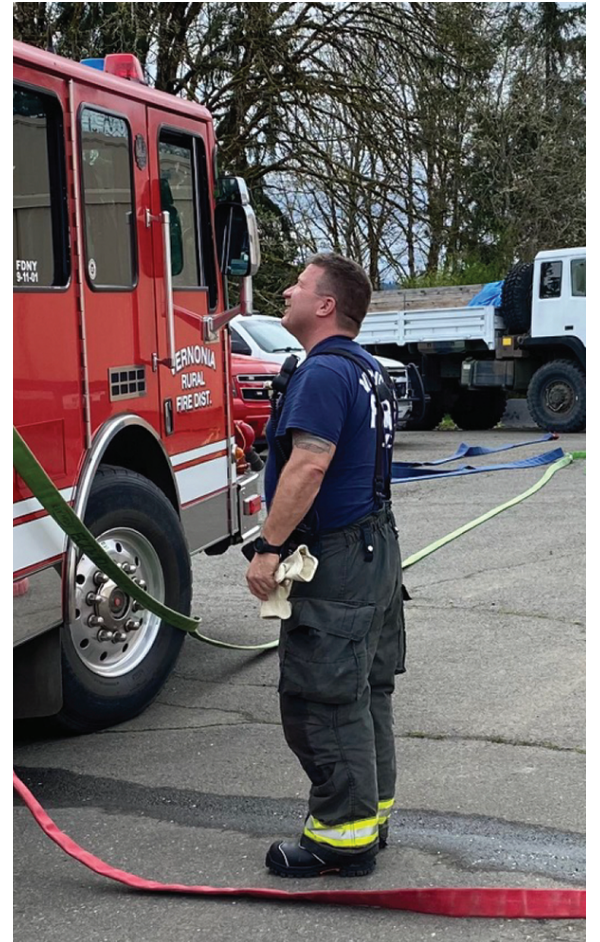
VERNONIA RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

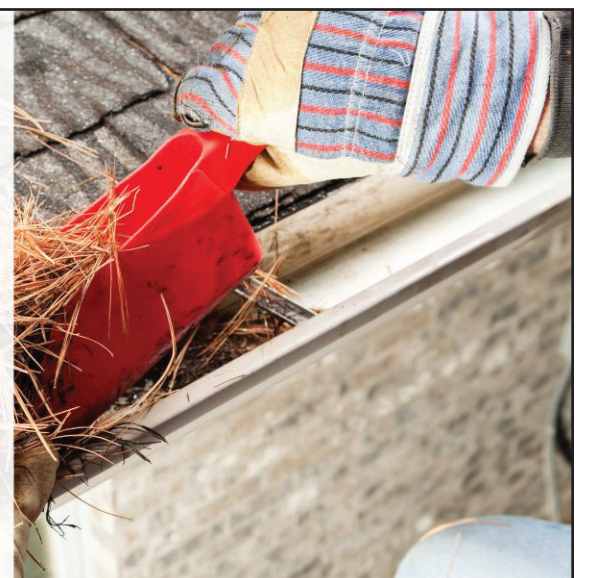
