Dispute leads to man being shot

Police arrive to find dead victim; shooter also injured

PLEASANT HILL — Deputies responded to a report of a dispute involving a firearm in the Pleasant Hill area on Wheeler Road.

Both the Lane County Sheriff's Office and the Oregon State Police went to

the scene, where they discovered a deceased man.

The initial investigation indicated that there was no continued threat to the community in connection with this case, and officials alerted the public that the area was now safe.

The investigation is ongoing, officials said. No other information was available at press time.

Also: Colton Tony Dick, 22, of Oakridge, pleaded guilty Aug. 19 to a single count of unlawfully taking an endangered species.

According to court documents, on Oct. 5, 2016, using a rifle and scope, Dick shot at an endangered gray wolf without legal justification as the animal was walking away from him in the Fremont-Winema National Forest.

Man dies after attacking police with knife

Lane County Sheriff's deputies responded to a Friday call around 10 p.m. regarding a dispute between a man and woman in the 37000 block of Row River Road in Cottage Grove.

Later, at 1 a.m., the Sheriff's Office received two 911 calls reporting that the same people were back at the location and again in a dispute. Deputies responded to the location and were initially unable to locate the woman, and received information that the man was in an outbuilding on the property.

Deputies used a loudspeaker in an attempt to get the man, Larry Leonard Lowry Jr., to come out of the outbuilding. After several minutes, the man exited the building and came at deputies with a large, fixed-blade knife.

Deputies shot the man as he advanced on them, and then performed CPR for several minutes until medics arrived and pronounced the man deceased.

Oregon among states with highest DUI fatalities

Anti-drunk driving campaigns started Aug. 14. Lending Tree used its data tool, QuoteWizard, to create an analysis of each state's DUI fatalities, and Oregon saw an increase of 6.20 percent in drunk driving fatalities from 2000 to

2017, ranking it as the sixth-largest rate increase in the country. Here are a few key findings:

Drunk driving fatalities nationwide decreased 18% overall from 2000 to 2017. Forty-three states nationwide saw a decrease in drunk driving fatalities from 2000 to 2017.

Minnesota, West Virginia and Alaska saw the biggest decrease in drunk driving fatalities from 2000 to 2017.

Oregon, Wyoming, California, Maryland, North Dakota and Maine are the only states that saw increases in drunk driving fatalities.

Seattle saw a 10% decrease in DUI arrests after Uber launch.

California reported a 6.5% decrease in alcohol-related crashes after Uber.

The Lane County Sheriff's Office is using grant money from the Oregon Department of Transportation and the Oregon State Sheriffs' Association.
