

New York Newspaper Suggests the Idea to Citizens of That Great Eastern Metropolia

It staggers the imagination to specuinte on the things that might happen if the list of social diversions in New York were enlarged to include the potlatch. That's a Siwash celebration along the northwest coast that the white man has suppressed by law, explains the New York Sun. A solltary outbreak of it the other day at Alert Bay, B. 
