Poultry Pointers From O. A. C.

Range and exercise are especially desirable for poultry breeding stock.

Egg size and shape are inherited. Gradual selection of those birds which, in addition to a large number, also lay "selects" will in time eliminate the birds laying the lower grade eggs.

Egg shell color does not affect the food value of eggs, but it does make a difference in the appearance. All brown or all white eggs will command the highest price.

Six roosters with each 100 hens should give good fertility and hatching ability with Leghorns.

An extra rooster is more desirable than one too few. Often sickness or accident takes one of the number and poor hatches result.
