The booklet covers the relation of properties of gasoline and of gasoline vapor to inflammability, precautions in handling gasoline, general asphyxiation by exhaust gases, gasoline fires caused by filtering gasoline through chamois skin, extinguishing liquid fires, use of foam or a frothy mixture to

PHILADELPHIA SETS EXAMPLE Cities which are becoming discouraged because of increasing traffic congestion should take a look at Philadelphia where a pathway has been plowed through a mass of masonry. The Quaker City has created a great parkway that connects her outermost sections with the heart of the municipality, demolishing 2,000 structures that stood across the path of her

pailty, demonstraing appropriate progress.

Not content with merely creating this parkway beginning 150 feet wide at the City Hall, then gradually expanding to 600 feet and extending more than a mile, Philadelphia has made provision for protecting it. No building may be erected within 200 feet of this parkway which does not conform to its character, no letter legible from it may be placed on any structure without the approval of the Park Commission, no roof sign may be erected.
