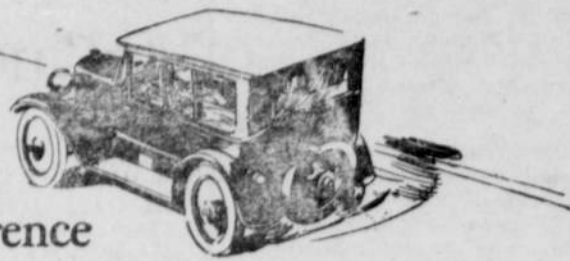

### Hunter Protected by Armored Suit Battles with Wolves

Details of one of the strangest experiments in the history of animal hunting are related by Stanley Clark-



son, of St. Paul, Minn., who spent a winter in the Canadian wilderness seeking "hand to hand" combats with hungry timber wolves. Dressed in an armor made of heavy leather studded with 1,200 needle-sharp steel spikes, he invited attacks from wolf packs while armed only with a short double-bladed ax and a hunting knife. Although handicapped by an exceptionally open winter and an unusually large number of wild rabbits, which kept the wolves from suffering from hunger, he killed a number of the beasts with his ax. During a snow-storm on Steep Rock Lake, north of Atikokan, he was set upon by five timber wolves. He killed two of them and wounded a third. The wolves seized the hunters arms and legs in their jaws, but could not do him injury because of the protruding spikes of the armored suit, which is made of specially tanned thick cowhide that will turn water and will not harden from rain or snow. There also is a helmet and heavy wire mask that can be raised to protect the face.

"No, sir," he replied gravely, "there's another little boy helping me."—Los Angeles Times.

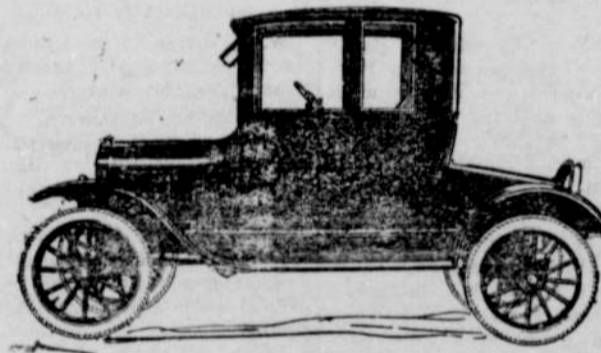
