Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received for the purchase of \$16,736.18, of Cottage Grove, Oregon, Improvement Bond Series "K" by the City Recorder of said City at his office in Cottage Grove, Lane County, Oregon, at 7:30 o'clock P. M., January 5, 1925, at which time and place the bids for said bonds shall be opened and considered by the Common Council, of said City.

Said bonds shall bear date the 1st day of January, 1925, and mature in ten years from date thereof and be redeemable at the office of the Treasurer of the city of Cottage Grove, Oregon, upon the payment of the face value thereof with accrued interest at the date of payment at any semi annual coupon, period, on or after one year from date of said bond. Said bonds shall be in denominations of \$500.00 each, except that one of said bonds may be of such denomination as will make up the total amount of the bonds hereby authorized and said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually after date thereof, principal and interest payable in Gold Coin of the United States at the office of the City Treasurer of Cottage Grove, Oregon. Said bonds will be sold for the highest price obtainable therefor, but not less than par and accrued interest. Sealed bids will be received for the purchase of all or any portion of said bonds, the Common Council, however, reserving the right to reject any and all bids.

A certified check for \$250.00, payable to the City Recorder of Cottage Grove, Oregon, will be required to accompany each bid as evidence of good faith and compliance with the terms of bid. The bonds offered are Bancroft Bonds, based upon street improvement as directed by ordinance No. 558, of Cottage Grove, Oregon, passed December 8th, 1924. If no bids are received for the whole amount thereof an offer for sale at or above par, the Council may negotiate and sell the said bonds, or any part of thereof at not less than par without re-advertising.
