**Post Card Rate Confuses.**

The new rate on postal cards other than government cards is causing much confusion upon the part of those mailing them and much trouble for postoffices. Any private mailing card requires a two-cent stamp. Many are yet mailing them with only one-cent stamps attached. Others are attaching the new one and one-half cent stamp. When insufficient postage is used, the postal authorities have to notify the addressee to send additional postage, which is expensive for the postoffice department and causes delay in delivery.

Government postal cards are sold at the old rate of one cent each.
