**CHRISTMAS SEALS SOON TO GO ON SALE**

Ninety-Five Per Cent of Receipts To Stay in State.

Fifty thousand dollars worth of Christmas seals will go on sale in Oregon, December 1, at a penny each and 95 per cent of the entire sale will be kept in Oregon to be used in the fight against tuberculosis by the Oregon Tuberculosis association, according to announcement by Mrs. Sadie Orr Dunbar, executive secretary of the association.

"The battle against tuberculosis which has been waged during the past 12 years, both by the National Tuberculosis association, of which Oregon is a part, and by other health agencies, has decreased the death rate from that disease by half and in the past 18 years approximately seven years have been added to the span of human life. "These are some of the reasons why we feel we are not asking the people of Oregon to perform a duty, rather we are giving them an opportunity to make a contribution toward better health and longer life," said Mrs. Dunbar.

**LANE HAS TAX RATIO OF 55 PER CENT**

Gilliam Is High With 90 Per Cent; Polk Is Low With 44.

Figures on state tax ratios for the various counties show that Lane's is 55 per cent, a slight increase from 1924 when the ratio was 53 per cent. In many counties of the state there has been quite a change. The ratio for Multnomah county has been set at 54 this year, last year it was 55 per cent. Gilliam

county has the highest ratio, 90 per cent, and Polk has the lowest, 44 per cent. In Clatsop county the ratio was decreased from 81 to 78, while in Columbia county the ratio was decreased from 76 to 71. The Harney county ratio was increased from 60 to 63.

These figures for the counties as compiled by the state tax commission are the ratio of assessed values to actual values.

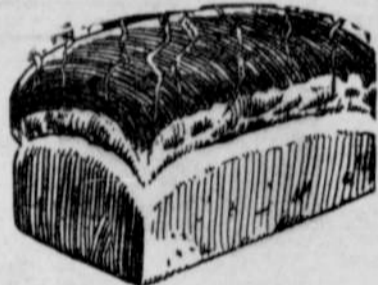
