few weeks to keep up a table supply as it is a quick grower. Thin the plants to eight or 10 inches in the row. Growth should be rapid and constant. They should be used when the enlarged stem is two or three inches in diameter and before it gets woody and strong.

Protect all these plants from leaf-eating insects with arsenate of lead, and from sucking insects by using some form of nicotine in either dust or liquid application.
