

Notice of School Meeting

Notice is hereby given to the legal voters of School District No. 45 of Lane County, State of Oregon, that a SCHOOL MEETING of said district will be held at the auditorium of High School building on the 20th day of June, 1932, at two o'clock in the afternoon for the purpose of discussing the budget heretofore set out and the levying board, and to vote on the proposition of levying a special district tax. HARMS CREEK

Sidney Bales, who has been home for some months from his work at Westfir, where he has been employed for several years as a timber feller, returned to his work the last of last week. This correspondent had the pleasure of looking over the Lee Thompson strawberry fields again this Saturday. Each field is now a mass of well grown berries largely of the Oregon variety, now ready for the ripening stage. Mr. Thompson predicts his first picking in about a week.
