For party food. 8 cups flour 1 tablespoon 4 teaspoons bak- grated orange ing powder 1/2 cup orange 1/2 teaspoon salt 1/2 cup marmalade 1/4 cup sugar 1 cup milk 1/2 cup nuts 1 egg. Sift flour with baking powder, sugar and salt. Add nut meats and orange rind. Combine marmalade with milk, add egg, well beaten, and stir all into dry ingredients. Beat well. Turn into greased loaf pan and bake in a moderate oven, 375 degrees, for one hour. Makes one good sized loaf.
