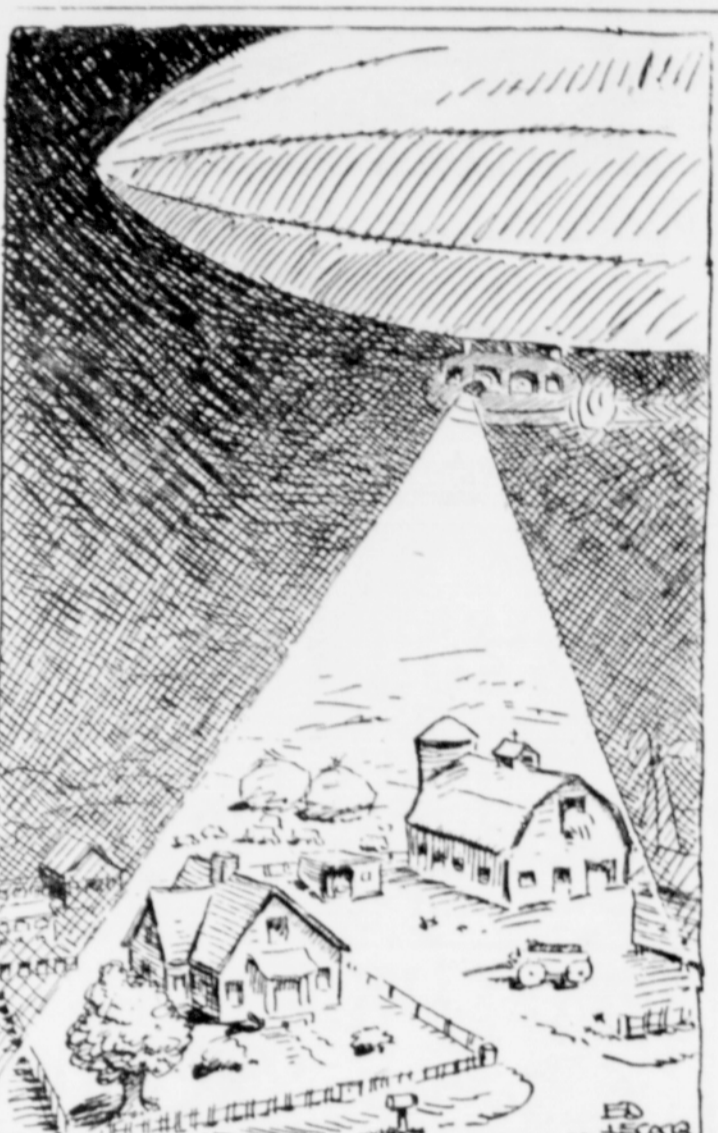

Avoiding Milk Flavors
To avoid undesirable milk flavors many dairymen feed highly flavored feeds before milking. Silage made from corn, alfalfa, sweet clover, or soy beans; and green alfalfa, cabbage, turnips, rape, and kale whet an hour before milking produce noticeable flavors in milk, tests by the United States Department of Agriculture show. Green rye, green cowpeas, potatoes, dried beet pulp, and carrots affect milk slightly. Green corn, green oats and peas, green soy beans, pumpkins, and sugar beets show little effect.

Texas plans to have 2,500,000 trees ready for planting next spring on a 300-mile shelter belt designed to reduce wind erosion.

The most intensely cultivated ground is believed to be in an area of 1,000 acres in Hertfordshire, England, which is entirely under glass.

For each city dweller in the United States farmers annually raise about one-fourth acre of wheat, three-fourths acre of corn and one-eighth acre of cotton.

The "Travelers' Aid"
