Elderly Woman Killed in Accident

Mrs. H. L. Edmunson, elderly resident of Goshen, was struck and killed by an automobile Monday morning on the highway east of Goshen when she was crossing the road to her home after going to the mailbox. The car was driven by Harry D. Jacoby, 19, U. of O. student and son of Mr. and Mrs. G. E. Jacoby, proprietors of Swimmer's Delight resort. District Attorney Ray will ask for a grand jury investigation. Mrs. Edmunson died on the way to a hospital.

Jurors Selected

Jurors for the June term of circuit court which begins Monday, June 7, were chosen Monday, May 24. Thirty-one names were drawn, none of whom are from Cottage Grove. The grand jury will be called for Tuesday, June 1, according to District Attorney Ray.

Rex Putnam, superintendent of schools at Albany for five years, was named by Governor Martin Monday to succeed C. A. Howard as state superintendent of public instruction, according to the county superintendent's office.

New Office Working Hours

New working hours for court-house employees will go into effect June 7, and provides that offices with only one deputy will not be open during the noon hour except Saturdays, when they will close at 1 o'clock. The offices effected are those of the school superintendent, 4-H club headquarters, county surveyor, county judge, juvenile officer, and the county treasurer.

4-H Summer School

The two-weeks summer school at Oregon State college for 4-H club members will be held from June 7 to 18 inclusive. All members over 12 years of age are eligible. One hundred or more are expected. Regular classes in 4-H work will be held and many forms of recreation are being planned. A party for all delegates and their parents is to be held at the club house on the fairgrounds Tuesday evening, June 1. Each club member is asked to bring cookies and ice cream will be served. This party will take the place of the regular leader's meeting.

Two Damage Cases Filed

Flynn, for personal injuries allegedly received in a car crash; and the other by Alice L. Wallis against L. D. Montgomery for \$3169.73 damages because of an alleged car collision on April 31.

Approval of the WPA project to construct bleachers and enlarge the grandstand at the fairgrounds in preparation for the coming Oregon Trail pageant was approved Monday and work will probably begin sometime this week. About 25 men will be employed on the project.
