Earthworms Require Moisture
 Earthworms thrive in almost all kinds of soils but they prefer those containing considerable organic matter and they must have abundant moisture. For this reason they are least numerous in very sandy areas. They commonly inhabit the upper 18 inches of the soil, but Darwin has shown that they may descend as much as six feet or more, when necessary. There are many kinds of them, most of which live in the soil but some live entirely in water. Various species differ in size; some in the tropics attain a length of six feet, but the common varieties found here seldom grow longer than 10 inches.

The Screech Owl
 The screech owl, called by some the little horned owl, is a familiar bird in many sections. It is not as secluded in habits as are other members of the owl family and often is found nesting in bird boxes put up for martins and flickers.
