Short Topics

A Pedestrian Safety Service auxiliary was recently organized in Portland for the purpose of promoting safe walking habits among those who seldom drive cars. Pedestrian societies have been active in England, where the pedestrian problem is even more acute than here, for a number of years.

Chicago has reduced night accidents at three of its most hazardous street intersections by 58 per cent since the installation of modern lighting units. A marked reduction in fatalities has also been noted in 16 New Jersey counties where up-to-date lighting has been installed.

An Oregon justice of the peace reports that a large crop of "spring speeders" has already appeared in his chambers this year, with a large number drawing convictions and sentences. Secretary of State Earl Snell reminds drivers that high speed is no safer during the spring than at most other times of year, and that the speed limits are no higher.
