NEW RELIEF MAP UNDER WAY AT U. OF O.

UNIVERSITY OF OREGON—The vast state of Oregon, its huge mountains, dashing streams, fertile valleys and plains, from border to border, can now be viewed in miniature as the result of work done by James Stovall and Mortimer Heinrich, staff members of the department of geology and geography of the university, it was announced by Dr. Warren D. Smith, head of the department.

The bird-eye view is a relief map of the entire state, approximately four feet each way in size. Using a jig-saw with which to cut thousands of tiny pieces of card board, the map makers built up every hill and change of contour, then carefully covered the whole with composition. From this, a plaster of paris mould will be made, and copies will be cast.

FISHING AT MT. RAINIER

SAN FRANCISCO, (Special)—Regulations for the 1939 fishing season in Mt. Rainier National Park, Washington, were announced today by the National Park Service, Department of the Interior.

Angling season in Reflection and Louise lakes is to open July 1 and to continue until September 10 and in Mowich lake from August 1 to September 30, with fishing hours limited from 4 a. m. to 9 p. m. Waters closed to angling include Tipsoo, Shadow, Green and Deadwood lakes, Ranger creek, Klickitat creek above White River entrance water supply intake and Laughing Water creek above the Ohanapecosh water supply intake.

Limit catches in streams, open since June 1, are 15 fish over six inches and in lakes 10 pounds and one fish with a maximum of 10 fish over six inches. No angling license is required within park boundaries.
