**News Briefs**

The district census office No. 4 has been opened in the Hampton building at Eugene by Mrs. Merle Stuart, supervisor. Nine counties are in the district including Benton, Lincoln, Linn, Lane, Douglas, Josephine, Jackson, Coos and Curry. Business and manufacturing census will start shortly after the first of the year, while the population count will start about April 1st.

Lane county has received a check for \$73,962.02 from Earl Snell, secretary of state for the county's apportionment of motor vehicle fees. The fund was received last week by Mrs. Grace Schiska, county treasurer.

National politics has started rolling before the close of 1939. Vice-president John Garner announced from his Uvalde, Texas, home Saturday his unconditional candidacy for the democratic nomination of the presidency. In the meantime, Thomas Dewey, the racket-buster, was making his second speech as the republican presidential candidate.

With Tennessee picked to face the U. S. C. football squad in the New Year's Rose Bowl game at Pasadena, the Trojans of U.S.C. began limbering up Monday after a week's rest from the Pacific Coast conference schedule completion.

Heywood Broun, 51, noted columnist and president of the American Newspaper Guild, died in his New York home Monday from an attack of pneumonia.

Twenty-eight applications have been made to sell over 265 tons of dried purnes to the surplus commodity corporation, according to an announcement from County Agent O. M. Fletcher's office. The county committee met in the county agent's office Monday to canvass the results of the grower's offer to sell.

The only unincorporated county seat in Oregon is Gold Beach, Curry county, according to the 1930 federal census. Gold Beach was formerly known as Ellensburg, Sebastool, and Whalesburg, according to the Oregon Writers' Project of the WPA. The present town still presents the evidence of the early pioneer gold rush which made colorful history before 1861 when a flood washed the placer gold workings out into the ocean. Small gold and platinum placer mines are still in operation at the mouth of the Rogue river. The town derives its name from this mining.

Peavy, who is retiring because of age limitations, will be president until July 1, and there will be no disposition on Ballard's part to infringe upon the normal completion of this term of office, he said.
