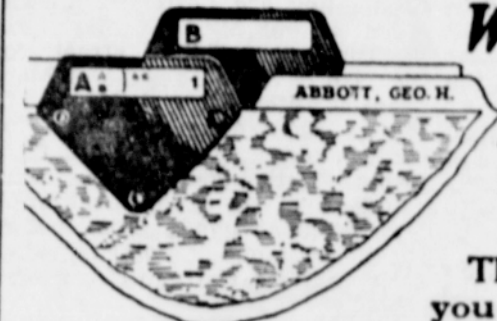
Bermuda Was 'Misfortunate'
