4-H club members from all over Lane county are planning on participating in the annual spring achievement exhibit to be held at the 4-H club building at the fairgrounds, Saturday, May 11. A system of judging all exhibits into grades of work will be used, and all exhibits will be placed in blue, red, and white ribbon classes.

All exhibits, which consist of the project work of the members, are due by 6:00 p. m., Wednesday, May 8th, with the exception of cooking exhibits which are due by 10:00 a. m. Saturday, May 11th.

Representatives of 1500 health club members will compete in the annual health round-up which will be conducted by the Lane County Health unit under the supervision of Dr. E. L. Gardner. The healthiest boy and girl will be selected and the winners will receive a half scholarship to either the 4-H club camp or the 4-H club summer school.

Included in the program for the clubbers will be demonstrations and judging, and a style revue for all of the sewing club members having exhibits on display.

Special achievement contests for club members to demonstrate the skills they have learned in their projects will be held in darning, stitching, and doll dress making for the sewing club members, cake, cookie and bread baking contests for cooking members, biscuit making for camp cookery members, forestry contests for forestry members, and sawing and nailing contests for handicraft members. Winners in the special contests will receive half scholarships to the 4-H club camp.

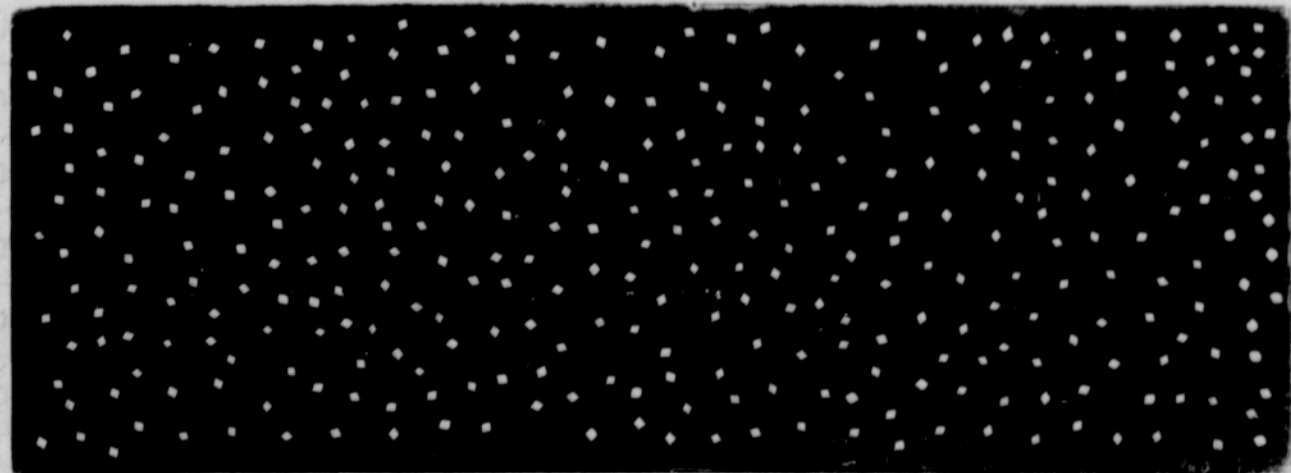
The old post office building at 24 North 9th street has been completely renovated and modernized as the new home for **PONTIACS** in Cottage Grove.
