SUBTERRANEAN CLOVER CAN "ROUGH IT"

CLARKES—Cultivated soil isn't always needed for a good stand of subterranean clover, found one Clackamas county farmer, according to County Agent John Inskeep. Ben Elmer here scattered subterranean clover straw as a top dressing on a rocky pasture and it produced as good a stand as on cultivated ground and is now furnishing ample feed for

sheep and cattle. The county agent's office has distributed 1500 pounds of subterranean clover seed the past year. Both spring and fall plantings seem satisfactory, says Inskeep, but growers are advised to plant early in the fall.
