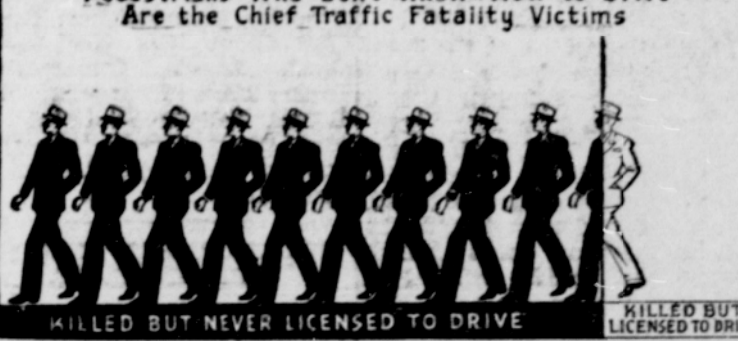
British Aim to Avoid Crete Fiasco on Vital Cyprus
