Above is an incomplete list of the Parent bureaus given birth by the Roosevelt New Deal administration. No attempt has been made to list the offspring. According to the Federal Register and the most reliable information obtainable, there were 2,241 of these agencies, bureaus and commissions on June 11, 1943—nearly 21½ times as many as are listed here! The members of these agencies and bureaus were never elected by the people and were never accountable to the people. They derived their power (and what power!) by New Deal appointment, decrees and directives.

To list the bureaus and departments having alone the right to undertake real estate transactions, develops into a major research project. The report covers 80 typewritten pages and shows 96 such bureaus, in the present government set-up (May, 1943). Most of them, tax-exempt, are competing with each other and with tax-paying insurance companies, banks, building and loan companies, and privately invested capital.

Wake up America! Stop, look and listen. Warning signs are at every turn. Duplication of effort, senseless wasteful red tape, and lavish and useless expenditure of your tax money.

Governments are like people. They can't continually spend more than their income and stay out of the poor-house.

Join the Freedom Army, November 7. Declare your independence from New Deal domination. Insure your job in the post war world-- and a job for that boy of yours. Declare your right to live your life in the American way without finger-printing regimentation, ruled and pushed around by an arrogant clique of crackpot theorists.
