SPRAY TIME FOR WALNUT BLIGHT

Now is the time to apply the early pre-bloom spray for the control of blight on walnut trees, it was announced Saturday by Ray Bower, county horticulturist inspector. Bordeaux spray 6-2-100 is recommended for the control of walnut blight in Oregon. Copper sulphate dust has also been used with success, says Bower.

The early pre-bloom application is made when about 50 per-cent of the buds have broken open and the longitudinally folded leaves are beginning to separate one from another, but before the leaf blades unfold. Other times of spraying for the control of this disease are the late pre-bloom application and the early post-bloom application.

It is extremely important that sprays be applied at the specified stages of flower development, for the success of the spray program depends on the proper timing of these applications, according to the inspector.
