DRIVE AGAINST TAX EVADERS

J. W. Maloney, collector of internal revenue, for the Oregon district, announced recently that 25 employees will be added to the Internal Revenue staff in this district to assist the treasury department's current drive against wartime tax evaders.

The efforts of these additional employees, together with the intensified effort of existing staffs, are expected, according to Secretary of the Treasury Henry Morgenthau, Jr., to collect at least a billion dollars of additional revenue from tax chislers all over the country.
