Dec. 3—Eugene, Ore. UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, WASHINGTON, D. C. Pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Act of August 28, 1937 (50 Stat. 874) and in accordance with 43 CFR secs. 115.4-115.5 and Circular No. 1608, it is proposed to establish the SIUSLAW MASTER UNIT, described below, in order to provide a basis for plans for the sustained-yield forest units and cooperative agreements authorized thereunder, as well as to facilitate administration under said Act. Hearings in connection with such sustained-yield forest units and cooperative agreements will be held after the establishment of the Master Unit. The boundaries, area, and location of the proposed Master Unit are as follows:
