Aids Washing
 A measuring cup and a ruler, kept near the washing machine, may help in saving soap and also in doing an efficient washing job. A soda about two inches thick has proved best for washing clothes clean. Too much soap is not only wasteful but does not do the best washing job. Too little soap does not get clothes clean. It is easier to add soap than to try to remove an excess. Just how much is needed depends on the size of the machine, the water, and the kind of soap used—whether flakes, chips, powder or jelly.

Wedding Ring
 The wedding ring dates back to at least the second century B. C., when it was merged with the betrothal ring. Its origin has been attributed both to the Egyptians and the early Romans. At first it was secular in significance, the Romans using a signet ring to indicate that the husband was endowing his worldly goods upon his wife and that she had the right to seal all such goods. The church apparently did not recognize the existence of a ring used in a wedding ceremony in the fifth century.

Harmful Insects
 There are, among the more than 625,000 species of insects known to science, only a very small per cent that are harmful to man or his possessions. A few years ago, when the department of agriculture's bureau of entomology listed all the insects that were then preying on the men, the domestic animals and the crops from one end of the country to the other, that list had a total of only 235 species! That is less than one-half of one per cent of the species known to entomology.

Hat Box
 A convenient hat box can be made by slitting down two corners of a square box, leaving the side attached to the bottom only. In opening, lift the cover, and with one finger the front can be let down.

Easy Canning
 During the busy canning season pick out the kettles and pans you use most frequently. Place them where you can reach them easily. Don't stack them and don't store them where you must stoop for them.

Control Corn Earworm
 Applications of light mineral oil can control earworm in sweet corn. For best results, a little oil is applied to the tip of each ear four days after silking, in order to give the corn a chance to pollinate first.
