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Ag Department to Launch 23 Million Dollar Road Plan

WASHINGTON—The agriculture department will complete this fiscal year a \$23,000,000 program of building and improving roads in national forests to facilitate hauling timber to aid veterans housing, a spokesman said last week.

He said this was included in the federal public works which John R. Steelman, reversion director, approved for construction by various federal agencies and departments.

The \$23,000,000 program is directed primarily at improving and constructing new access roads to get vitally needed timber to lumber mills.

Of this, about \$6,000,000 is to be expended for rehabilitating old roads and trails, \$1,000,000 is for various equipment and materials, while about \$16,000,000 is earmarked for new access roads.

The spokesman said some of the work has already started, some is in the planning stage, but all roads included are expected to be completed by next July 1.

A breakdown of the \$16,000,000 for new roads in national forests by states, includes:

Oregon, \$4,270,000; California, \$3,437,000; Idaho, \$1,961,000; Washington, \$1,798,000; Montana, \$1,477,000.

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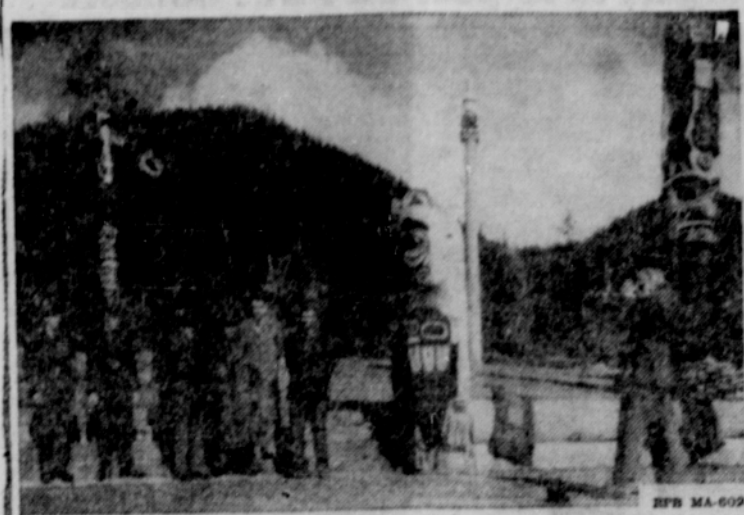

Visit to Heaven Is Described by Young Evangelist

An attractive young woman who asserts at one time her spirit left her body, ascended to heaven in a ball of light and then returned after a three-hour sojourn in heaven, will describe her experience Sunday night at the Assembly of God church, Miss Lola V. Wiseman of Oklahoma City, is conducting evangelistic meetings at the church which are to continue next week.

Miss Wiseman states that the things she saw were as she expected except that "Our Lord does not look like the portraits of Him." She also asserts that during her stay in heaven she saw many persons who were converted in her ministry before their death, and that they joyously welcomed her into the heavenly throng. This experience, she says, is in four different scenes of unusual interest. She talked personally with the Lord and He revealed many things to her that she will relate, she says. Miss Wiseman said that for many months previous to her experience she had been working very hard as pastor of a new church in Justin, Texas, attempting to build up the congregation and that a doctor had pronounced her with leakage of the heart and had warned her against laboring too strenuously.

Potato Bugs and DDT

You can credit DDT to potato bugs. First invented by a Swiss chemist in 1874, DDT laid on the shelf for more than half a century. Maybe people were frightened by its chemical name—dichloro-diphenyl-trichloroethane. Then in 1939 the old discovery was revived to fight potato bugs with great success, in Switzerland. A few years later the U. S. Medical Department began the series of developments which have now made DDT a familiar household word throughout the land.
