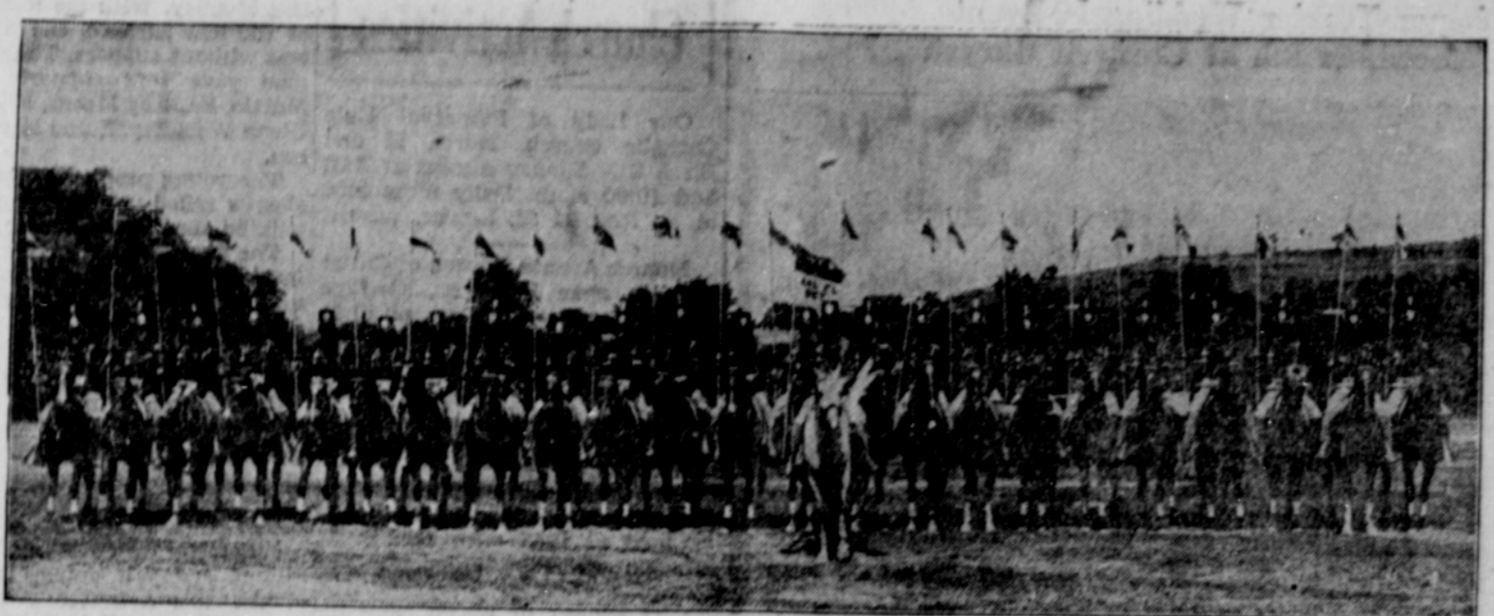
PLEASANT HILL LAD SAVES PAL
Eleven-year-old Phillip Snethen of Pleasant Hill is credited with saving his riding companion, David Neet, 7, from serious injury when David's runaway horse threatened to crash into the side of a moving train.

David and Phillip, along with Johnny Erbach and Loyd Leabo, all of Pleasant Hill, were riding near their home when David's horse started its "runaway" down a road leading to the Southern Pacific track where a train was approaching.

Phillip spurred his own mount and, slapping the runaway about the head, he managed to turn it just as the pair reached the tracks. David's horse then slipped off the steep railroad right of way, throwing the boy to the ground.

Phillip rode on down the track beside the moving train, across a narrow bridge, endeavoring to stop his own animal. However, it stumbled on a stone and rolled down the bank, carrying him with it.

Both boys received emergency treatment at the Sacred Heart hospital Sunday after the accident. David suffered a bruised leg and Phillip a fractured foot.

OREGON HENS SET RECORD FOR OCTOBER PRODUCTION
Oregon hens set a high production record in October at an average of 11.19 eggs each, the Department of Agriculture's crop reporting service said today.

The average was the highest ever recorded in the state for October and was well above the national average of 9.2.

The number of laying hens on Oregon farms was estimated at 2,527,000, a decline of 3 per cent from October last year.

VETERANS BUY FOUR BUILDINGS
Word reached Salem Wednesday that only four buildings out of 585 to be disposed of at Camp Adair will be sold to veterans.

Regional war assets administration headquarters in Portland announced that bids for four buildings were the only ones accepted, among 26 which covered 61 buildings. Others were rejected as being too low. One bid was in the amount of \$1. Offering to the public will start November 22 or 23.

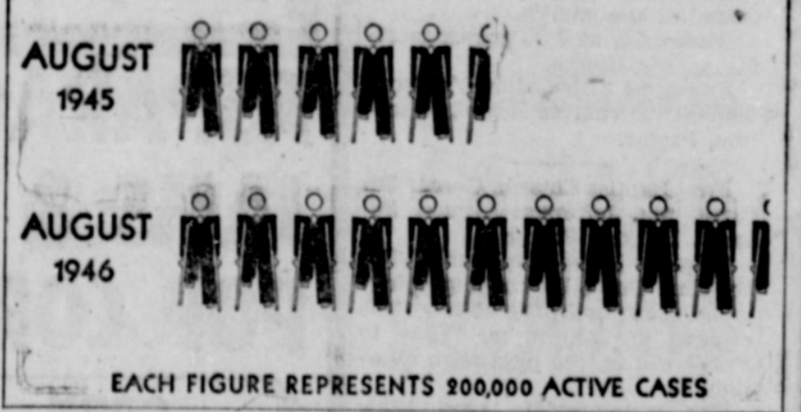
Bidding now passes to the general public with terms remaining the same, officials said.

VETERANS DRAWING DISABILITY PENSIONS OR COMPENSATION



The number of veterans receiving disability pensions or compensation practically doubled during the first year following the surrender of Japan, Veterans Administration officials reveal. In August of 1945 there were 1,103,000 on the disability compensation rolls. One year later, the Veterans Administration was paying disability claims to 2,073,000. This increase is shown graphically above.
