Different Woods Are Being Studied

The first phase of a project in wood products research that may take 20 to 30 years to complete has been started by the Oregon Forest products laboratory at Oregon State college in cooperation with the Southern Pacific railroad. The study involves testing different woods for use as cross-ties to replace species commonly used that are getting more scarce.

Ties made from two species, western hemlock and white fir, have already been sent to the Southern Pacific wood preserving plant at Eugene to be treated. At least six additional species are to be sent there by May, according to Dr. Phinister B. Proctor, technical director of the laboratory. Among the species to be compared with Douglas fir now commonly used are Shasta red fir, ponderosa pine, lodge pole pine, incense cedar, Sitka spruce and both the coast and interior types of Douglas fir.

The experimental ties will be air seasoned, treated with a creosote and oil mixture and placed in test tracks where they will be checked regularly during their service.

The results of this investigation are expected to contribute valuable information on better utilization of Oregon forests and to furnish one of Oregon's largest wood consuming industries with data that will enable it to prepare for future contingencies, said Dr. Proctor.

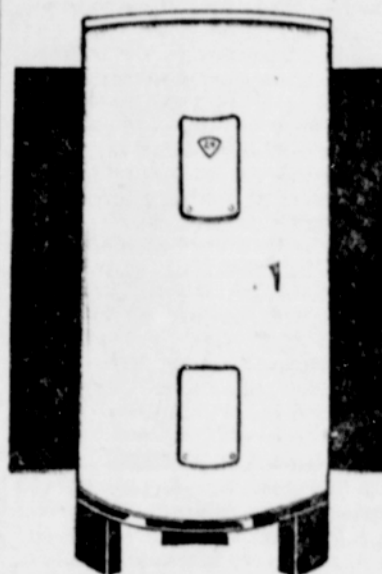

Need Running Water
Running water still is lacking in 75 per cent of the farm homes of the nation. Only 5 per cent of city homes lack running water. A farm family of five with a fair amount of livestock uses about 300 tons of water in a year if they have to pump and carry it by hand. If the farm had running water and electric pumps the same family would use probably twice as much water and have none of the effort of transporting tons of water by hand.

Sportsmen's groups will be interested in the announcement by the Reclamation Service of the hearing to be held on the Rogue River Basin Project on June 8 at the armory building in Medford. At that time a complete discussion will be held on all phases of the project, including fisheries. If dams are constructed on the main Rogue, as tentatively planned, a sport fishing loss of more than \$2,000,000 a year has been estimated.

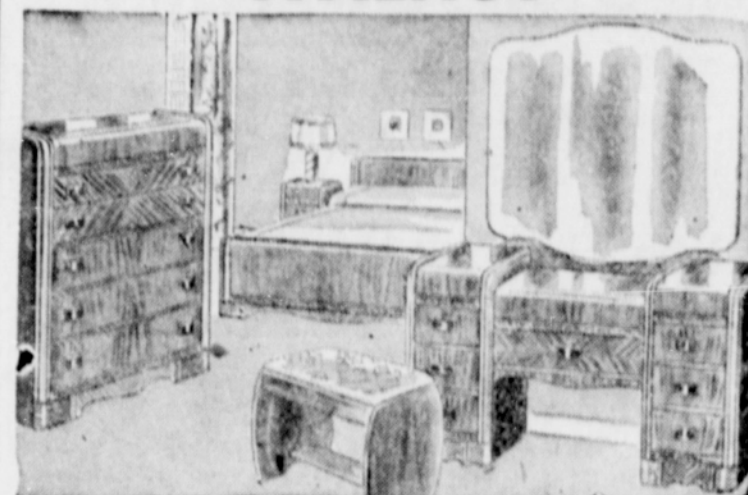
Prevented Scurvy

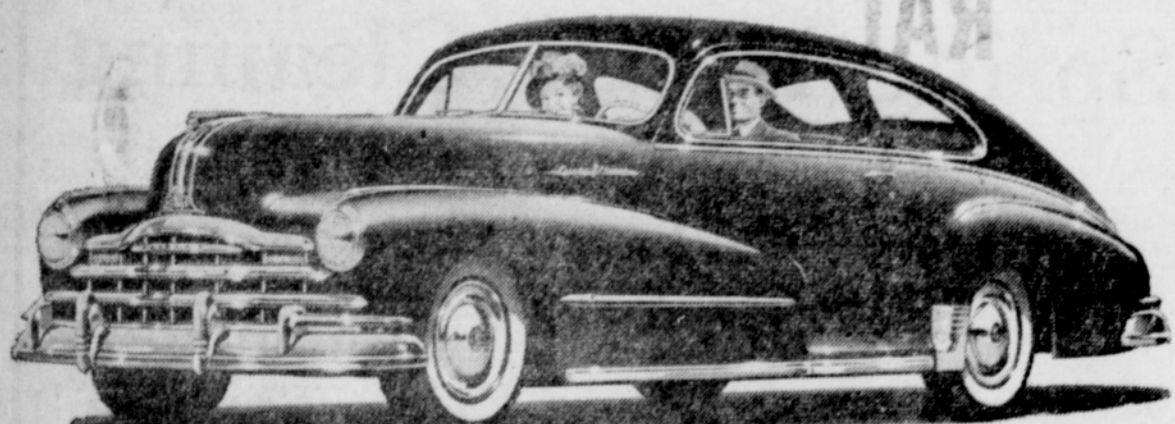
