### NOTICE OF TIMBER SALE

Sealed bids, marked outside "Bid for Timber", and addressed to the Regional Administrator, Bureau of Land Management, Region 1, Swan Island Administration Building, Portland 18, Oregon, will be received until and opened at 10:30 a.m., Pacific Standard Time, May 11, 1948, for the purchase of all merchantable timber designated for cutting upon tracts hereinafter described; the cutting and removal of the timber to be carried out in accordance with the forest practice rules approved on July 7, 1938, by the Secretary of the Interior. Each bid must state the amount per thousand feet, board measure, that will be paid for each species and the total consideration which will be paid for the timber. No bid for less than the appraised value will be considered. Each bid must be submitted in duplicate and be accompanied by a deposit. The deposit must be in the form of a certified check on a solvent bank and in favor of the Treasurer of the United States. The amount of the deposit will be \$5,000.00 provided the total amount bid is over \$5,000.00 and less than \$50,000.00; it will be \$10,000.00 provided the total amount bid is over \$50,000.00 and less than \$100,000.00; it will be 10% of the amount bid when the bid exceeds \$100,000.00. If the total amount bid is less than \$5,000.00, the deposit shall be the amount of the bid. The deposit will be returned to unsuccessful bidders; applied as a part of the purchase price of the successful bidder; or that portion of the deposit representing the minimum required by law, shall be retained as liquidated damages if the high bidder does not execute contract and furnish satisfactory bond within thirty days of acceptance of the bid or cannot furnish evidence of his ability to comply with the local marketing requirement. ## Watch Labels on Fertilizer Bags

When buying fertilizer look for the label that tells the minimum amount of plant food—nitrogen, phosphorus, and potash—that are contained in the sack.

This suggestion is made by Arthur S. King, O. S. C. extension service soils specialist. He says the current shortage of fertilizer, particularly nitrogen, has resulted in a general price rise. Much of the increase is legitimate, brought about by high transportation and production costs. In some instances however the increase in price is purely speculative.

The general scarcity of fertilizer has made it possible to sell material that falls below a specified grade, or even worse, to sell material that carries no guarantee as to the plant food content. Under Oregon law, King points out, dealers are expected to register their various grades of fertilizer with the state department of agriculture. The law also requires that all fertilizers be plainly marked with a label showing the minimum amount of the three plant foods, nitrogen, phosphorus and potash which are contained in it.

Established dealers conscientiously live up to the requirements of the law, King states. Thus, buyers may safely compare the fertilizer values on the basis of the label. Because of the increased cost, farmers can well afford to be more particular than ever about the plant food content of the material. If the material contains the needed plant food, the use of fertilizer will be profitable regardless of the higher price, King states.

There are a number of methods of evading the law, however, and many types of material can be sold for application to the soil without carrying the necessary guarantee. It should be obvious to everyone, King emphasizes, that material that does not carry the standard label should be looked upon with suspicion.

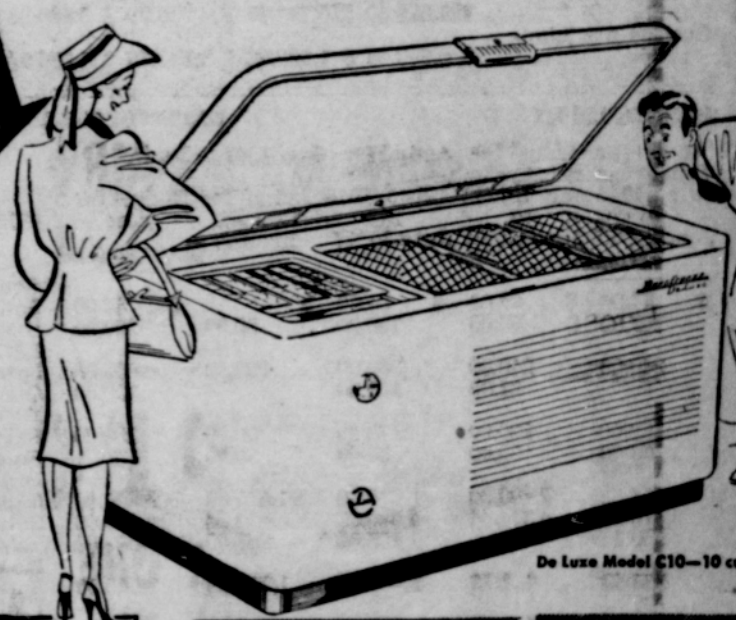
