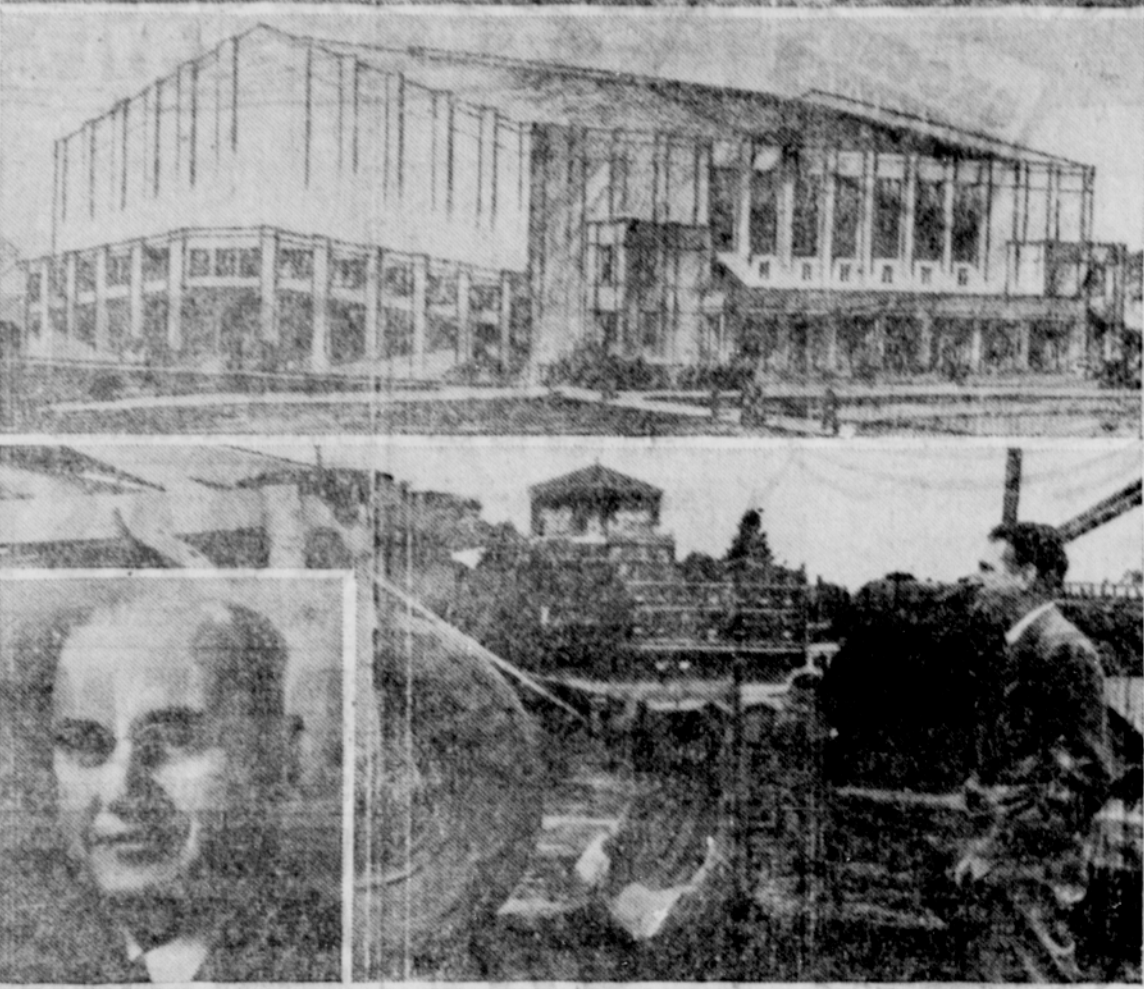
Eldon Whitehead and W. Saunders flew to Wallowa for a fishing trip over the week end.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: That at a special election to be held in the City of Cottage Grove, Lane County, Oregon, on Thursday, the 5th day of August, 1948, from the hour of eight o'clock A.M. to the hour of eight o'clock P.M. of said day, and at said special election, there will be submitted to the electors of the City the following question: "Shall the City of Cottage Grove, Oregon, be authorized to exceed the constitutional six per cent limitation as provided for in Section II Article XI of the Constitution of Oregon by the sum of \$16,588.47 for the purpose of providing additional funds as follows, to-wit: \$6,338.47 for street improvements, maintenance, repairs and sweeping, \$3,600.00 for sinking fund for street equipment, \$3,250.00 additional for police, \$3,000.00 additional for emergency fund and \$1,000.00 for Fire Department."
