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Strawberry Plants Must Be Inspected And Certified Not Later Than April 18

Strawberry growers who expect to apply for inspection and certification of strawberry plants this year are invited to call at the county extension office in the Public Market building in Eugene, according to W. B. Parker, county extension agent. Plants must be in the ground and application for certification on file by April 18 so that the tour of field inspections can be started.

The object of strawberry plant certification is to provide sources of strawberry plants that are true to name and that are practically free from diseases and insect pests. In 1948 four Lane County farmers entered a total of 11 acres of strawberries for plant certification and the plants grown by two growers representing seven acres

were approved for certification. There was a great demand for certified strawberry plants last fall and there has been this spring, says Parker. Growers have not been able to purchase as many certified plants as they desire.

Mulching Strawberries
Pine straw, which is considered the best material for mulching strawberries, should be applied during the winter after the first growing season.

Licenses Starting In R5 to Expire End of April

Every Oregon driver's license with a "5R" serial number will have expired by the end of April, Secretary of State Earl T. Newby has announced.

Stressing that the old permits with serial numbers beginning with "5R" have been expiring in consecutive blocks since June, 1947, regardless of the date printed on the license, the secretary warned that state and local police are citing many drivers who failed to renew on schedule.

As a result of intensified police checks a flood of current and delayed "5R" renewals is pouring into the license department, jumping from 17,676 in February to 30,438 in March. They are replaced with new permits which expire according to the holder's birth date.

Pointing out that an expired license is the same as no license at all, Newby urged all holders of "5R" permits to file renewal applications immediately. Fee schedules may be obtained from the sheriff or police department, or from any drivers' license examiner.
