Vets Neglect to Record Discharges

A spot check of county court houses by the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs this week revealed that an alarming number of war veterans have neglected to record their military discharges as a safeguard in the event of loss of their original papers.

Slightly more than half the estimated World War II veteran population of Multnomah, Clackamas, Columbia, Washington and Yamhill counties have taken advantage of free recording service provided by law, inquiries by the state veterans' agency disclosed.

The total World War II veteran population of the five counties is estimated conservatively at 81,000. A tabulation of recorded discharges in the five counties as reported by county clerks or recorders showed that only about 43,700 veterans had made their military discharges a matter of permanent record.

"This indicates that veterans generally are neglecting to protect one of their most valuable possessions," said William F. Gaarenstroom, director of the state veterans' department.
