Tansy Threatens Livestock



Tansy ragwort, common ragwort, staggerwort, or stinking Willie—whatever you call it—now is the time to spray for best and cheapest control. This weed, poisonous to cattle and horses, is spreading rapidly throughout western Oregon, states Rex Warren, O.S.C. farm crops specialist, shown examining a tansy plant at the stage when 2-4-D spray is effective. Apply 3 pounds of parent 2-4-D acid per acre and before plants reach bud stage. After brilliant yellow flowers appear, more expensive material must be used.
