

Marines Now Accepting Applicants for Immediate Service; Policy Unchanged

PORTLAND, OREGON — Dismissing a current erroneous belief on the part of the general public Captain G. E. Lawrence, officer in charge of the Portland Marine Corps recruiting office, announced that the Marine Corps is accepting applicants for immediate enlistment.

Wide opportunities for furthering their education are offered all Marines through a number of service schools, as well as thru the famed Marine Corps Institute, which for the past 28 years has offered free correspondence courses in nearly 200 fields of knowledge. Interested young men may secure full details about the Marines by writing the Marine Corps Recruiting Station, Room 208, New U. S. Court House, Portland, Oregon.

The current enlistment period is four years and accepted applicants are sent from Portland to the Marine Corps recruit depot in San Diego, where they are given a 10-week course of recruit training. Wide opportunities for furthering their education are offered all Marines through a number of service schools, as well as thru the famed Marine Corps Institute, which for the past 28 years has offered free correspondence courses in nearly 200 fields of knowledge. 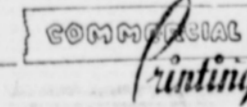

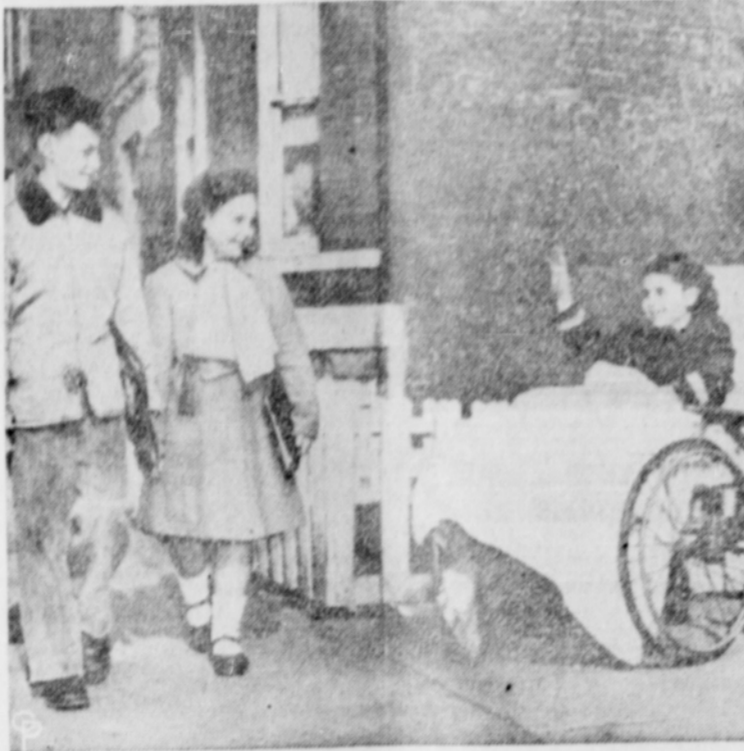

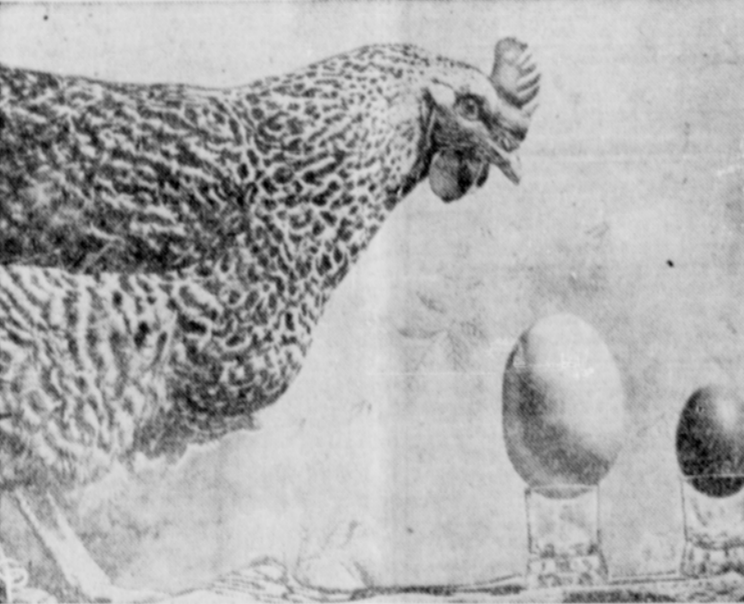
