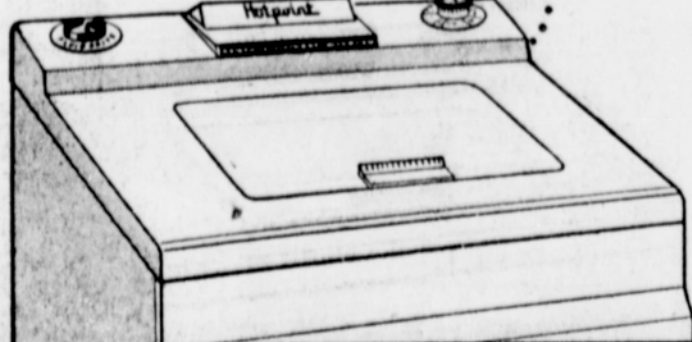

A medico says an excellent way to reduce is to wash the dishes. Not if, in order to save

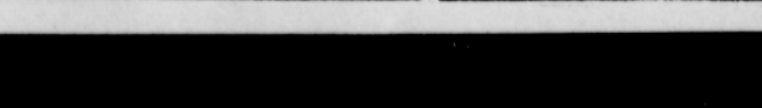
on soap, hot water and elbow grease, the platter is first licked clean.
