THIS HISTORIC 950-YEAR-OLD royal crown of Hungary is reportedly involved in a "ransom" deal proposed by Budapest for release of the American businessman, Robert A. Vogeler (below), now serving a 15-year sentence for alleged espionage. State Department efforts to free Vogeler supposedly induced Hungarian willingness to exchange him for the gem-studded golden crown. Presented in 1001 A.D. to King Stephen I by Pope Sylvester II, it was looted by the Nazis and recovered in Germany after the war by United States Army forces. (Central Press)
