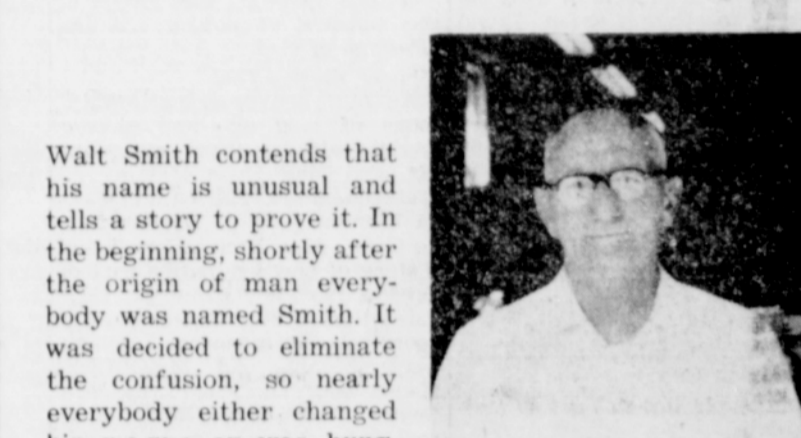

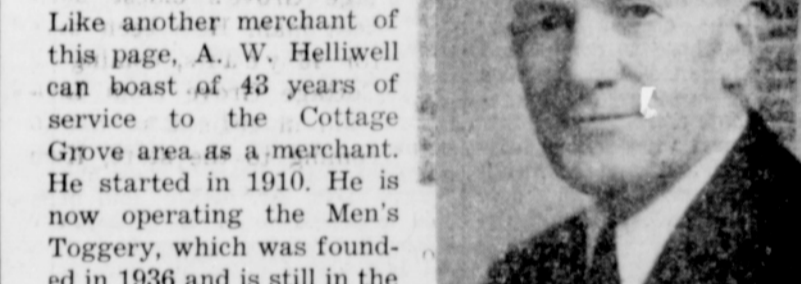
The Western Auto is one of the pioneer firms in the auto supply business. Stocked also is a line of household items, paints and garden and lawn tools and appliances.

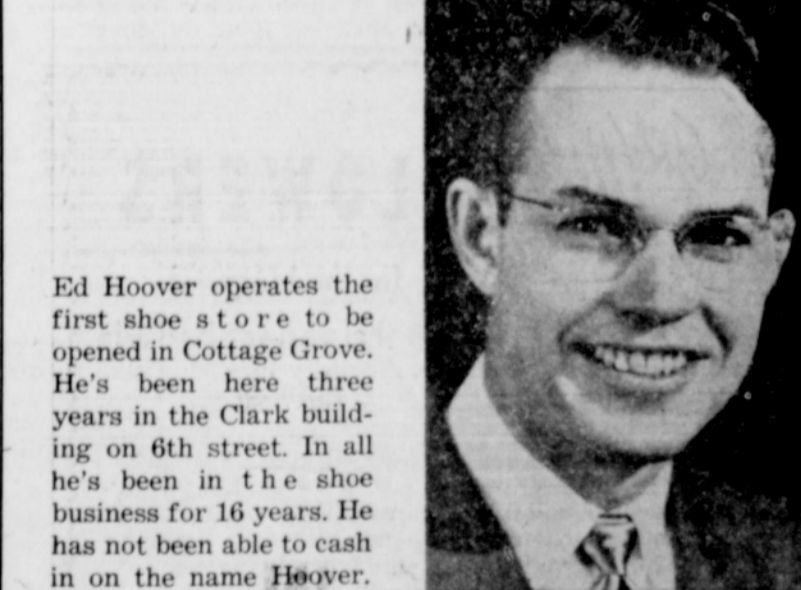
That left only a few Smiths including Walt and the Smith Brothers who make cough drops. And the only difference between Walt and the brothers is that the latter grow whiskers.
