

Public Invited To Textbook Survey

The State Board of Textbook Commissioners invites examination by the public of all textbooks being submitted for adoption on November 15. Rex Putman, Superintendent of Public Instruction said today. All comments should be submitted to the commissioners by October 30.

Adoptions will be in elementary and secondary social studies, home making, music, art, and conservation, and high school biology, physics, and physical science.

The books are available for examination at the office of each of the commissioners and the secretary, Joseph I. Hall, State Department of Education, Salem. Members of regional teacher-evaluating committees also have copies of textbooks being submitted. Social studies texts are available for examination at depositories established by the commissioners at various central locations throughout the state.

Depositories for social studies texts are located at the Deschutes County School office, Bend; Coos County School office, Coquille; Library, Southern Oregon College, Ashland; Library, Eastern Oregon College of Education, La Grande; State Library, Salem; Instructional Materials Library, Portland Public Schools; and Central Library, Portland.

Addresses of teacher committee members who have copies of the textbooks may be obtained by writing the secretary of the Commission.

Oregon Cattle, Potato Men Hold Joint Banquet

A beef-vegetable dinner was held last night at the Mallory Hotel in Portland to kick off the "Beef Stew and Beef Pot Pie" promotion in Oregon. A proclamation issued by Gov. Paul S. Patterson on September 10 officially proclaimed September 15 to October 15 as "Beef-Vegetable Month" in the state.

Over 100 members of the beef, vegetable, wholesale and retail trade, as well as members of the press, radio, television and industrial home economists, were guests of the Oregon Cattlemen's Association and the Oregon Potato Commission. The main course was a glorified "beef stew" prepared by the hotel chef, Nicholas B. Podpah.

One of the highlights of the dinner was a meat cutting demonstration, conducted by Barney Dain, Portland meat instructor, demonstrating the large number of desirable, inexpensive cuts that come from a side of beef.

Mrs. Blanche Fritz and Mrs. Jack Sugg, both of Portland, represented consumer organizations and spoke briefly on the need for promotions such as this to educate the housewife in the purchase and use of meats and vegetables that have seasonal large supplies.
