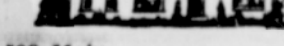

vs. ANNIE L. WHITTED, Defendant. IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF OREGON: You are hereby required to appear and answer the Complaint filed against you in the above entitled suit on or before August 18, 1955, or for want thereof, the Plaintiff will take a Decree against you as follows, to-wit:

(a) For an absolute divorce from the Defendant.

(b) That Plaintiff be adjudicated the sole owner of the following described real property, to-wit:
