Tested Recipes

Apple and Carrot Conserve—One quart ground or dried carrots, one quart of diced tart apples, two sliced oranges, two cups sugar, salt. Cook the carrots in sufficient water to cover them until they are tender; do not drain them. Add the other ingredients and cook the mixture until it is clear.

Baked Beef Heart—Cut open and remove the ventricles and let soak an hour in salt water. Wipe dry with a cloth and parboil about 30 minutes. Make a rich stuffing, fill the heart, and secure it with a string. Let it make two hours with one-half pint of water in the pan. The gravy will not need any thickening.

Cinnamon Toast—When wondering what fit the titbit to serve with the afternoon tea or chocolate, try cinnamon toast. Cut bread rather thin, trim off

the crusts, cut in two diagonally and toast to a rich brown. Brush with melted butter and sprinkle with a mixture of sugar and cinnamon, put in the oven for a moment until the butter and seasoning soak in. Serve immediately, piled up on a hot plate.

Sugarless Apple Pie—Make a good pie crust and line a deep pie plate. Put four tablespoonfuls of molasses in the plate, sprinkle with flour and fill plate with apples. Use a little salt and one-third teaspoonful nutmeg. Sprinkle

more flour over the top, cover and bake slowly one hour.

Household Hints

To Keep Ribbons Fresh—Wind ribbons, when not in use, around a smooth bottle, fastening the ends with pins to keep them in place. To renovate black ribbons, pour a pint of boiling water

over a teaspoon of soap bark. Let this stand a few minutes and then strain. Lay the ribbons on a flat surface and sponge with the liquid. Do not iron but roll the ribbon smoothly over a large bottle filled with hot water and let it remain there until dry.

Washing Embroideries—An excellent method for preventing colored embroideries from losing tone when washed is to put them through bran water. The bran may first be boiled, the water strained off and the bran then

added to the water in which the work is to be washed in the proportion of a handful of bran to a pint of warm water, or the bran may be boiled in a bag, so as to be strained by one and the same process.
