

Peninsula businesses look to solar power

100-year-old institution among those going green

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LONG BEACH — A blazing September sun loomed overhead as two men installed the final solar panel atop Marsh's Free Museum.

"There's more and more solar going in the area," said Precision Solar, Heating & Indoor Air Quality owner Stan Tussing, pausing to

observe the work completed with co-worker Chuck Waddell on the roof of the 100-year-old Long Beach business that's turning to 21st-century technology to become more energy efficient.

"We installed around 50 panels. It will be about a 20,000-watt system," Tussing said.
