Use: "These were built as beach seiners up in Alaska. They would seine their fish then, if they had to, they could run them high and dry up on the beach," said Florian Mumford, the owner of the boat. "It has a flatter bottom so it doesn't roll over. Right now it's just for crab fishing, but this boat will fish all-year around. We do black cod, salmon, albacore, halibut and crabs. This crab season has been one of the best for me on record. Getting to start on time was huge."
