As part of the annual Toledo Art Walk on Labor Day Weekend, the Toledo Art Guild will host a two-day art sale on Saturday and Sunday, Aug 31. and. Sept. 1.

During the sale, guild members will demonstrate art techniques every hour on the hour from 11 am to 3 pm on both days.
