Before long, he was breaking his mother's plates and throwing his father's knives in the woodshop, which led to his enrollment in the Aarhus Theater Academy.

In the early '90s Bothe moved to Seattle and headlined as an entertainer for major cruise lines while working on "Neon Man," a glow-in-the-dark optical illusion that



has been his ticket to television appearances all over the world. He also perfected his plate spinning routine.

Bothe has appeared on many programs, including ABC's recent remake of "The Gong Show," with Jay Leno on "The Tonight Show," and in Las Vegas at Caesar's Palace and on Europe's most widely viewed variety show "Le Plus Grande Cabaret du Monde" in Paris.

He currently resides with his wife and family in Portland, where he performs locally, leads team-building workshops and teaches a circus arts program in metro-area schools.

An Afternoon of Magic and Ice Cream will begin with ice cream served from 1 to 1:30 pm, with Bothe taking to the stage from 1:30 to 2:30 pm.
