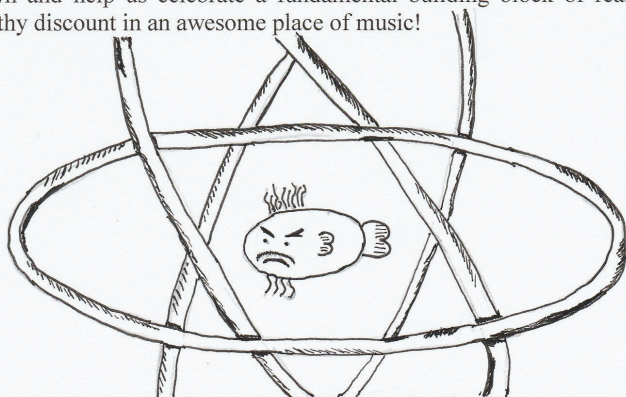


Graviton Sale!
