A great habit to pick up


Lincoln City's Driftwood Public Library is now offering no-contact curbside pickup, allowing patrons to pick up items at the library's staff entrance on Galley Street, on the west side of the building.

The service is available to any Driftwood cardholder with an account in good standing (owing than \$25 in item fees) and

is limited to one visit per household per week and 10 items per card. Library patrons can request items through the online catalog at encore.oceanbooks.org, contact the library by phone at 541-996-2277, or email the library at librarian@lincolncity.org. Once the items are available, staff will contact patrons to schedule a pick up appointment time.
